Among the main improvements are updated electronics, compatibility with standard flush-mounted boxes, availability in black and white versions, and a high-quality acrylic surface. TOCA panels are designed to deliver reliability and ease of use, making them the ideal solution for professional audio environments where design, functionality, and installation flexibility are essential.

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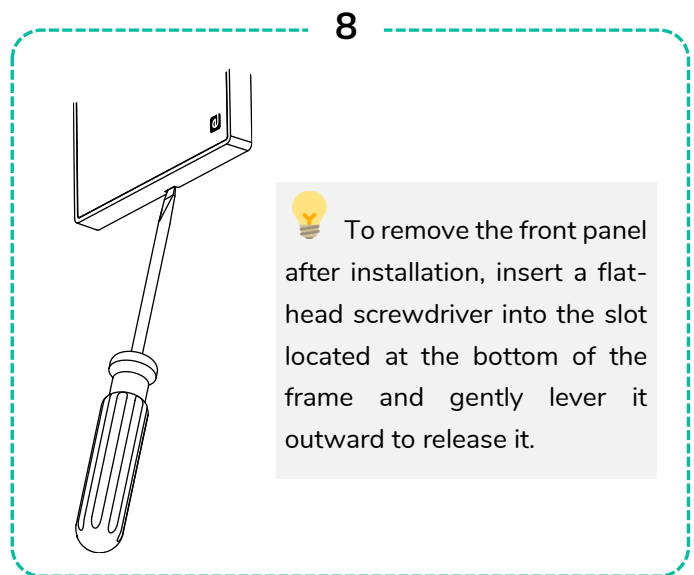
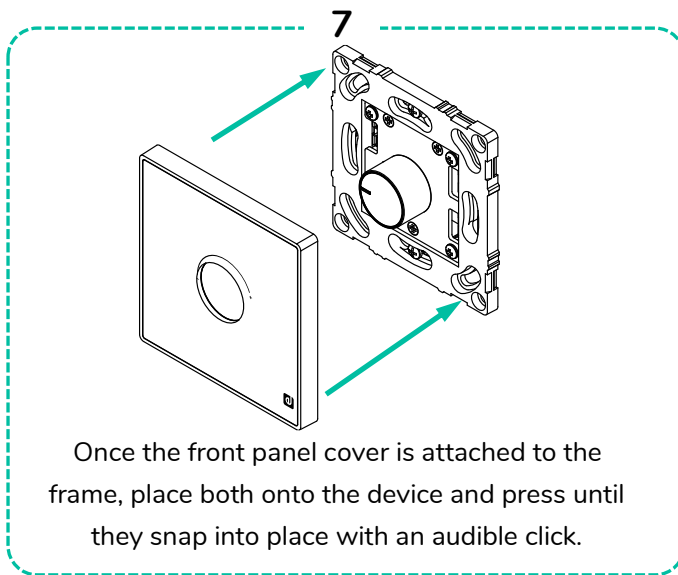
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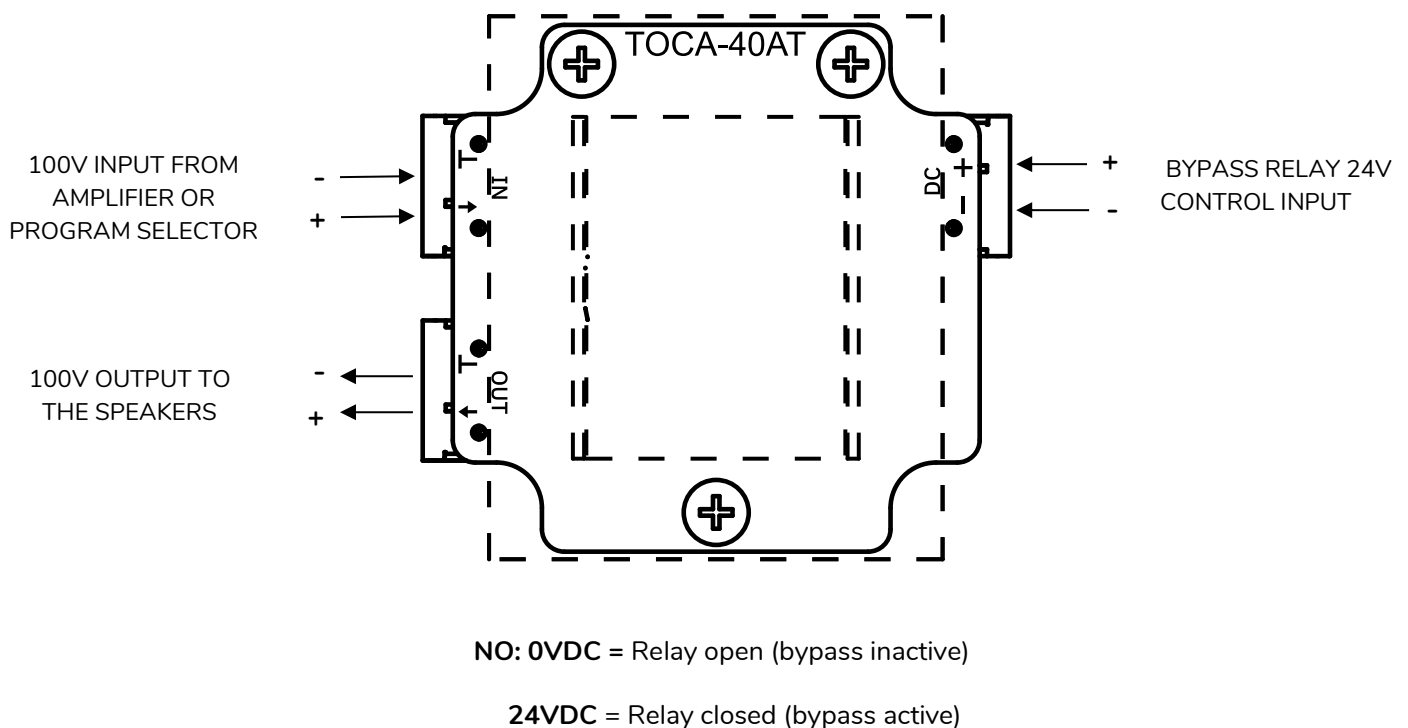
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7. REMOTE CONNECTORS

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7.2 TOCA-CXJRCA

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8. MIXER / CONTROL DEVICES

8.1 TOCA-MIXT

TOCA-MIXT is a wall-mounted control panel designed for applications requiring simple mixing management and local audio signal control, combining ease of use, elegant design, and seamless integration into professional environments.

The microphone input includes a two-band equaliser (Bass/Treble) and can operate with priority on the line signal when the microphone exceeds the preset detection threshold.



8.1.1 Main Features

- Unbalanced stereo line input (1 x minijack).
- Balanced MIC input with BASS and TREBLE controls and selectable Phantom power.
- Independent volume controls for LINE and MIC inputs.
- Talk-over function available (MIC over LINE).
- External PSU required. To ensure correct operation, the use of the Ecler WP24-PSU power supply is recommended. It can power up to ten TOCA-MIXT units, depending on voltage losses caused by cable length and sections.
- Can be combined with a TOCA-CTRL1 unit to work as a remote audio input for HUB Series digital.
- Compatibility with standard flush-mounted boxes.
- High-quality acrylic surface.
Available in white (RAL 9003) or black (RAL 9005).
- Optional double frame for installing two TOCA Series units side by side.
Available in black (TOCA-2FRBK) or white (TOCA-2FRWH).



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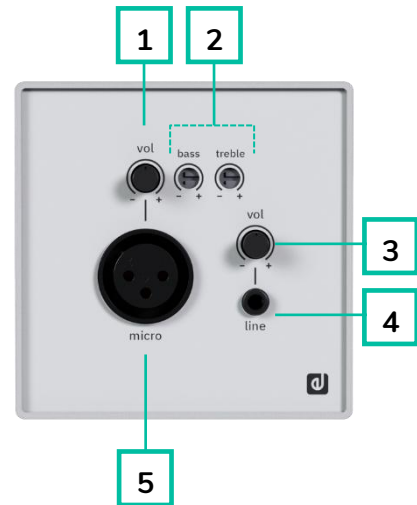
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8.1.2 Panel Functions

1. Volume control at the microphone input.
2. Bass (100 Hz) and treble (10kHz) tone controls at the microphone input (± 10 dB).
3. Volume control at the line input.
4. Minijack line input connector (unbalanced signal) .
 - Sensitivity: -12 dBV.
5. XLR connector at the microphone input (balanced signal) .
 - Sensitivity: -20 to -40 dBV.



The Line and Microphone signals are mixed with relative levels depending on their respective VOL volume controls. This mixing is available at the Euroblock connector output terminals of the unit (unbalanced signal, line level is 0 dBV). Furthermore, the microphone signal may use the Talkover function in order to automatically attenuate the line signal when the microphone signal reaches the Talkover detection threshold. For detailed instructions on activating the Talkover function, please refer to the Configuration Diagram chapter.

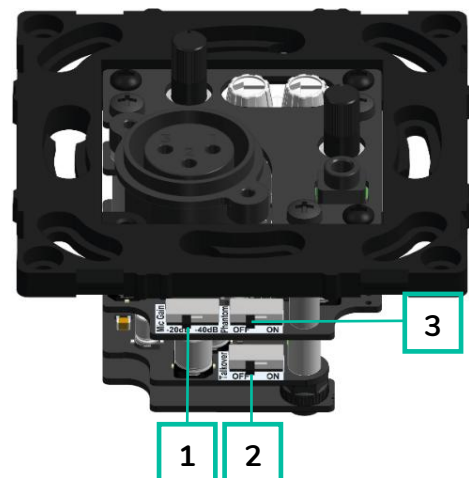
! *TOCA-MIXT requires an external 24VDC (min 40mA) power supply connected to terminals 4 and 5. For correct operation, the use of the **Ecler WP24-PSU**, which can power up to ten TOCA-MIXT units (depending on voltage losses caused by cable lengths and sections).

! Since the TOCA-MIXT does not incorporate any electromagnetic shielding, we strongly recommend that it is installed well away from power sources and high-voltage cables.

💡 For the installation of a TOCA-MIXT unit next to a TOCA-CTRL1 wall panel on surface or flush mounting, see the **TOCA-CTRL1** user manual.

8.1.5 Configuration Diagram

1. **MIC sensitivity selection:** -20 dBV (default position) or -40 dBV.
2. **Talkover function:** ON / OFF (default position).
 - Talkover attenuation over the line input: 30 dB.
 - Talkover maintenance time three seconds.
3. **Phantom power supply for the MICRO input:** ON / OFF (default position).



! This operation must be performed with the unit power supply switched off.

8.2 TOCA-CTRL1

TOCA-CTRL1 is a digital wall control compatible with HUB Series and configurable through the web application embedded. It allows you to configure source selection, volume control and equalization for a given zone, including all or some of the functions.



8.2.1 Main Features

- Digital wall control panel compatible with HUB Series digital zoners.
- Volume adjustment, source selection and EQ (programmable).
- Compatible with TOCA Series panels with audio connector, for sending audio, control signals and DC supply over a single CAT5 or higher cable.
- Can be combined with a TOCA-MIXT to work as a remote audio input for HUB Series digital zoner.
- Optional external PSU (24VDC). Compatible with Ecler WP24-PSU power supply unit.
- Compatibility with standard flush-mounted boxes.
- High-quality acrylic surface.
- Available in white (RAL 9003) or black (RAL 9005).
- Optional double frame for installing two TOCA Series units side by side. Available in black (TOCA-2FRBK) or white (TOCA-2FRWH).



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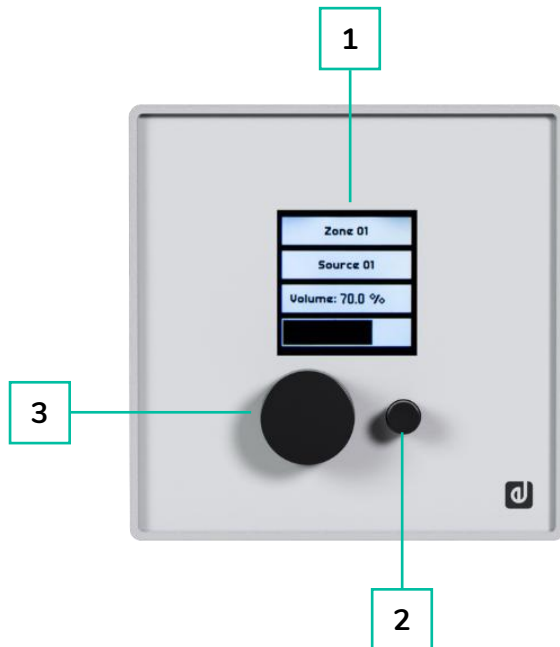
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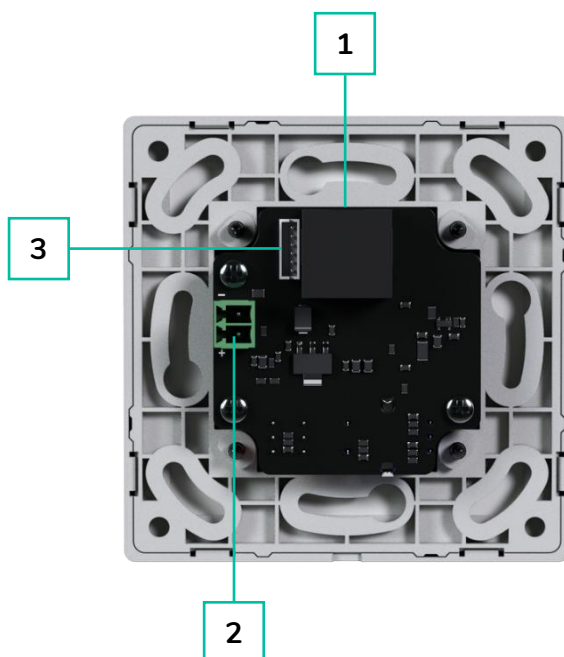

- B. If the cable length requires an external power supply, connect the PSU to the supplied Euroblock connector, then insert the connector into the device. **Refer to the cable-length limits and PSU wiring section.**
- C. If the device is used together with a TOCA-MIXT unit, connect both units using the supplied wire connector with the TOCA-MIXT unit. In this configuration, Connector A is always required, and Connector B is required depending on the cable length.

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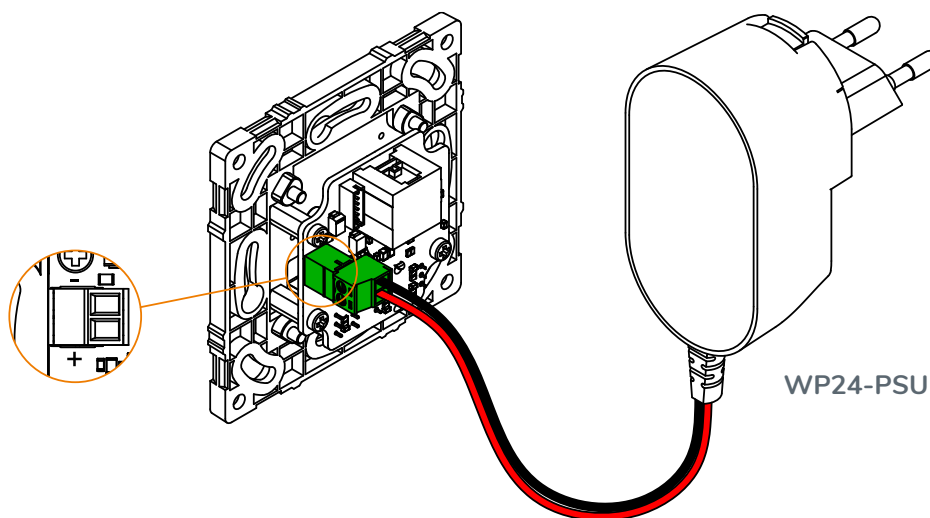
8.2.4 Cable Length Guidelines and External Power Supply Connection

The maximum lengths for CAT5 or higher cable connecting TOCA-CTRL1 to a HUB unit depend on the AWG category of the cable used. Examples:

	AWG24 Cable Max. Length	AWG23 Cable Max. Length	AWG22 Cable Max. Length
TOCA-CTRL1	270 metres	340 metres	425 metres
TOCA-CTRL1 + TOCA-MIXT	85 metres	105 metres	130 metres



If the cable length exceeds the recommended limit shown above, the TOCA-CTRL1 may continue to operate, but noise may be superimposed on the signal entering the TOCA-MIXT. To avoid this, power the TOCA-CTRL1 with an external 24 VDC PSU (the Ecler WP24-PSU is the recommended option). With an external PSU and good-quality CAT5e cable, digital data exchange between the HUB unit and TOCA-CTRL1 has been successfully tested over wiring distances of up to 600 metres.



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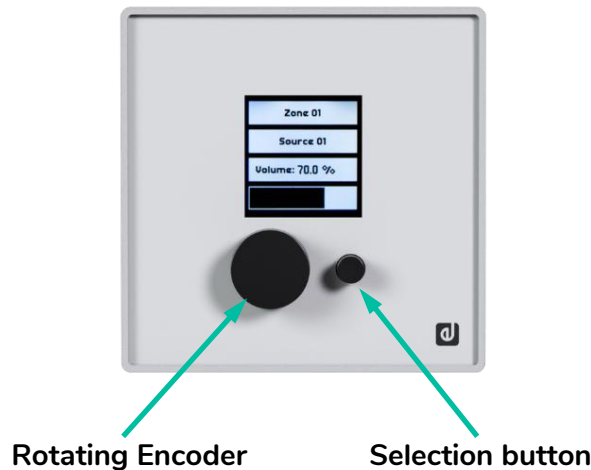
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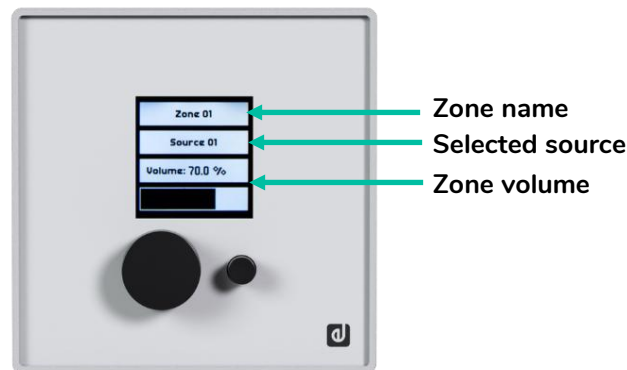
8.2.5 Start-up & Operation

8.2.5.1 Controls

TOCA-CTRL1 features 2 controls on its front panel:



The main screen provides information, including the controlled zone's label or name, the currently selected source, and the zone's volume level.



8.2.5.2 Navigation and Operation

- **Selection Button (Short Press):**
 - Use the selection button to toggle between source selection and volume control modes. The currently editable option is highlighted with a white background. When an option is selected, the corresponding indicator (VOL or SEL) will be framed and blinking.
- **Rotary Encoder:**
 - **Volume Control (VOL):** Rotate the encoder to adjust the volume for the selected zone. Changes are applied instantly.



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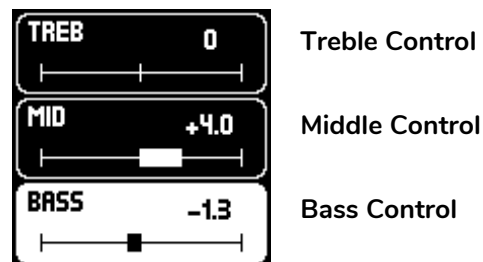
- **Mute Function:** Press and hold the encoder for 2 seconds to enable or disable the mute function for the zone.
- **Source Selection (SEL):** Rotate the encoder to scroll through the available sources*. During scrolling, no changes are made until a source is selected. The name of each source will flash as you scroll. Press the encoder to confirm and apply the selection. If no selection is made after a few seconds, the system will revert to the previous state without applying changes.



* The available sources can be selected using the HANGAR application. For comprehensive instructions and additional details, please consult the HANGAR web application section in the HUB Series user manual.

8.2.5.3 Equalization Screen

The equalization screen allows users to adjust the tone controls (treble, middle, and bass) for the selected zone.



To enter the Equalization Screen:

- Press and hold the selection button for 2 seconds.

Navigating and Adjusting Tone Controls

- Once on the equalization screen, use the selection button (short press) to cycle through the available tone controls: Treble, Middle, and Bass.
- Adjust the selected tone control by rotating the rotary encoder to the desired value.

To exit the Equalization Screen

- To return to the main screen, press and hold the selection button for 2 seconds.



If no adjustments are made for several seconds, the system will automatically revert to the main screen.

8.2.5.4 Information Messages

This section describes the status and informational messages displayed by TOCA-CTRL1 during operation and system events.

- **Firmware Update**

- **Automatic Firmware Update:** When a TOCA-CTRL1 unit is connected to a HUB device, it automatically checks for firmware updates. If an update is required, the process is performed automatically, without manual intervention. The message "UPDATING FIRMWARE" will be displayed during the update, which typically completes within a few seconds.
- **Paging Station Initialization:** When connecting an **eMPAGE** paging station to the PAGER port of a powered-on HUB unit, it is normal to restart all connected paging stations and TOCA-CTRL1 controllers. This process takes a few seconds, after which all devices become fully functional.

- **Device Status Screens**

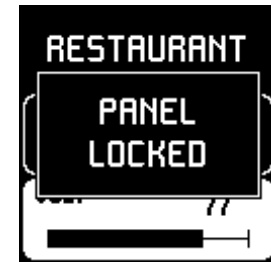
- **INFORMATION:** Press and hold both control keys for a few seconds to access the information screen. This screen displays the name or label of TOCA-CTRL1 (which may differ from the main screen area label, as programmed via the HANGAR web application) and the current firmware version. Firmware updates are managed automatically when connecting to a HUB device, ensuring compatibility. Manual firmware updates are not required.
- **DISABLED:** Displayed when the device is disabled via the unit's global enable setting in the HANGAR web application.
- **OFFLINE:** Displayed when the device is not connected to a HUB unit or if there is a connection issue.



- **DISABLED CONTROL:** Displayed when attempting to use a control (volume, source selection, or equalization) that is disabled for the TOCA-CTRL1 panel.



- **PANEL LOCKED:** Displayed when the temporary lock is activated for the user. To activate or deactivate this lock, press and hold both the selection key and rotary encoder for approximately 5 seconds. After 2 seconds, the information screen will appear; continue holding until the lock message is displayed. Unlocking uses the same sequence.



This hidden function is useful for temporarily protecting the system from unauthorized manipulation (e.g., during events to prevent attendees from changing sound content or volume).



- **PANIC ACTIVE:** Displayed when the PANIC button (muting all 16 audio outputs) is active. This function is accessible via the HANGAR web application.
